

## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

Between: The Department of Vermont Health Access (DVHA) and  
Vermont State Colleges (VSC)

Subject: MCE Investment in Health Professional Training

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this MOU is to provide for the administration and funding of certain VSC programs invested in by DVHA, the State's Managed Care Entity (MCE), under the Global Commitment to Health Waiver.

This MOU is for the period **July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015**.

### **Programs**

The special terms and conditions for the Global Commitment to Health waiver identify four allowable uses for projected surplus revenue from capitation payments. Specifically:

- Reduce the rate of uninsured and/or underinsured in Vermont
- Increase the access of quality health care to uninsured, underinsured, and Medicaid beneficiaries
- Provide public health approaches and other innovative programs to improve the health outcomes, health status and quality of life for uninsured, underinsured, and Medicaid-eligible individuals in Vermont
- Encourage the formation and maintenance of public-private partnerships in health care, including initiatives to support and improve the health care delivery system.


**Specifically, the dollars expended under this arrangement are intended to increase the access of quality health care to uninsured, underinsured, and Medicaid beneficiaries.**

The MCE investment amount appropriated for state fiscal year 2015 is \$409,461.

Administration of the above program is the sole responsibility of VSC. It is to be administered in accordance with the requirements of OMB Circular 110 as codified in 42 CFR Part 92 and 2 CFR Part 225 until 12/26/14 and after 12/26/14 in accordance with the requirements of OMB Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards, Final Rule (Uniform Guidance). This appropriation from the Global Commitment Fund includes an award of Medicaid Federal funds CFDA #93.778. The Vermont State Colleges will provide the following information to DVHA within sixty calendar days following the close of the State fiscal year:
