

Public Announcement

The Department of Vermont Health Access (DVHA) has changed the rates paid for hospice care services, effective October 1, 2013. Payment for hospice services is at a per diem rate, based on Medicare rates which are adjusted for Medicaid and published annually. The fiscal impact of these changes is an annualized increase in payments of \$10,044.34.

This Announcement of rate changes to hospice services made by DVHA applies to individuals covered under the State Plan and the Global Commitment (GC) to Health Waiver. The State Plan is also the guiding document for changes applicable to the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) and the Choices for Care program, which are not covered by the GC to Health Waiver. Changes to the GC population are being made pursuant to the flexibility authorized under the GC Waiver, specific to Sections 1902(a)(13) and 1902(a)(30) of the Social Security Act, which allows the State, through the DVHA, to establish rates with providers on an individual or class basis without regard to the rates currently set forth in the approved State Plan.
