IMPORTANT NEWS ABOUT YOUR MEDICAID, DR. DYNASAUR, OR VERMONT HEALTH ACCESS PLAN COVERAGE

Chiropractors

- **As of July 1, you may go to a chiropractor for any service that state law says chiropractors can provide. The chiropractor must be enrolled in Vermont Medicaid.**
- You will not need to get a referral from your primary care provider.
- In order for you to get more than ten visits in a calendar year, your chiropractor will need to ask for a prior authorization.
- Children under 12 need prior authorization before getting any services.

IF YOU CURRENTLY ARE ON VHAP-ESIA (EMPLOYER-SPONSORED INSURANCE ASSISTANCE)

Because chiropractic services are included in the VHAP benefit as of July 1, VHAP pays co-pays, co-insurance, and deductibles for these services. The chiropractor must be enrolled in Vermont Medicaid.
