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The MOMS Program

Who is Eligible?

Pregnant women who are insured solely by Medicaid and have at least one of the following conditions:

- History of a delivery prior to 32 weeks gestation
- Diagnosis of Opioid Use Disorder
- Currently are receiving Medication Assisted Therapy (MAT)
- Diagnosis of Mental Illness

A collection of documents including a 'Welcome to the Medicaid Obstetrical and Maternal Support (MOMS) Program' brochure and a 'MEDICAID OBSTETRICAL AND MATERNAL SUPPORT (MOMS) PROGRAM' referral form. The form includes sections for patient information, provider/facility information, and reasons for referral.
