

Considerations for the Top 5% for VCCI case selection

Rather than mandate the selection of members by targeting certain health conditions, members are selected based on factors such as, but not limited to:

- a) Acute settings utilization
- b) Polypharmacy and/or medication non-adherence
- c) Multiple providers
- d) Predictive models and,
- e) Health costs

The Disease / Case Management category is further stratified using defined criteria and interventions.

Disease Stratification for Top 5%:

- Acuity Level 3
Inpatient \geq 90 days ago
 \leq 2 avoidable ED visits within last 30 days
3 or fewer chronic conditions
<3 providers with inconsistent visits
Moderate Gaps in adherence to standards of care
- Acuity Level 4
Inpatient >30 days ago
 \geq 2 avoidable ED visits within last 30 days- or current ED use
Newly diagnosed condition
Significant gaps in adherence to standards of care
4 or more chronic conditions
Complex care needs
Inpatient > 3 times in past 6 months
Multiple physician specialty visits with evidence of uncoordinated care
May have polypharmacy and non-adherence
- Acuity Level 5
Currently admitted
Inpatient within last 30 days
Face To Face Interaction to support Transition of Care needed
Intense monitoring and coordination needed
Complex Care Needs with high risk for gaps in care and re-admission
May have polypharmacy and non-adherence
