Integrating Family Services Rate Allocation

Policy Summary:

The Agency of Human Services (AHS) has increased rates for the three Integrating Family Services (IFS) agencies. IFS brings children's, youth, and family services together in an integrated and seamless continuum. Flexible funding allows service providers to meet family needs as they become known. The three agencies are Addison County Parent Child Center, Northwestern Counseling and Support Services, and Counseling Services of Addison County. This rate increase is a result of a 2016 legislative session appropriation, as well as funding reallocated based on caseload from the Department of Disabilities, Aging, and Independent Living (DAIL) for the JOBS Program.
