## \*\*Attention Pharmacies \*\* Important Update on Early Refill Overrides with Submission Clarification Code (SCC) 13

In response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (PHE), Vermont Statute authorized pharmacies to override the early refill edit. This was implemented using the NCPDP Submission Clarification Code (SCC) =13 for the adjudication of pharmacy claims. This code indicates that an override is needed based on an emergency/disaster situation recognized by the payer. The state requirement to allow the early refill expires 3/31/2023. Therefore, **effective 4/3/2023**, DVHA will no longer allow the use of SCC 13. Pharmacies must call the Change Healthcare Help Desk for an override at 1-844-679-5362. The Help Desk will assist to ensure members continue receiving sufficient supplies of medications for chronic conditions.
