The Medicaid and Exchange Advisory Committee represents provider groups, small business' and healthcare advocates and Vermont Medicaid/healthcare consumers. We are currently looking for new members to represent the small business and consumer communities. The committee's job is to make recommendations to the Department of Vermont Health Access (DVHA) about processes and policy: As a Committee member you will:

- Learn and discuss Federal and Vermont's healthcare policies and initiatives
- Contribute your voice and opinion toward shaping Vermont's healthcare landscape
- Participate in discussions with key leaders in Vermont healthcare

No prior policy experience necessary and resources are available to help new members learn about healthcare in Vermont.

Members are asked to participate in at least nine meetings per year, either in person or by phone. Meetings are held the fourth Monday of each month from 10:00am – 12:00pm at the Waterbury State Office Complex in the Oak Conference Room, unless the group decides otherwise. ***(Due to the COVID-19 emergency, meetings are not held in person and are conducted online via teleconference until further notice.)***

Examples of key issues include:

- Healthcare payment reform
- Changes to federal healthcare law
- Medicaid and Exchange (Vermont Health Connect) operations and outreach
- Medicaid budget impacts for the Department of Vermont Health Access, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Disabilities, Aging and Independent Living and the Vermont Department of Health
- Review of healthcare rules changes, and proposed state legislation
